Aim of training Course

In the field conditions, a veterinarian who is the crucial middle level livestock extension functionaries need to provide input services to augment production and health services in addition to extension and information services. A good livestock extension professional requires efficiency in both process and technical skills addressing livestock farmers' needs.
