Vast resources spread all over NARES can be made accessible by few clicks. For library users all over NARES, an Online Public Access Catalog (OPAC) of their own library provides easy and enhanced experience of using library online, sitting at their desk either in lab or home. Even while on move they can access their library using smart phone. Integrated catalog of whole NARES (AgriCat) provides access to holdings of other libraries of NARES.

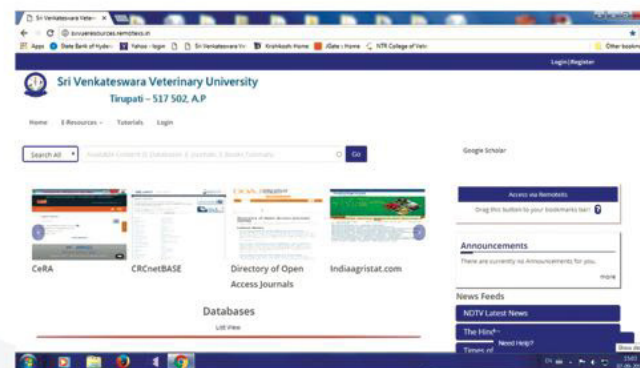

SVVU E-RESOURCES PORTAL

Due to the advent of ICT's many information sources are available in the form of e-resources like E-Journals, E-Books, E-Databases, E-Courses etc. ICAR is subscribing various e-resources for ICAR Institutes & SAU's and providing access through 'Consortium for e-resources in Agriculture (CeRA)' portal. In addition to that SVVU is also subscribing certain e-journals, e-books and e-databases. Due to the lack of static IP facility at certain Colleges, Research Stations, Polytechnics, KVK's of SVVU, most of these e-resources are not accessible to our Faculty, Scientists and Students. To overcome this problem remote login software called 'Remotex.in' has been acquired and separate portal for SVVU has been developed. All the staff and students of SVVU can access these e-resources by login through User Name and Password on <http://svvueresources.remotex.in> portal provided they have net connectivity.

Procedure for obtaining User Name and Password:

For accessing e-resources on <http://svvueresources.remotex.in> portal, User Name and Password is essential for each individual. The individual's e-mail ID will be User Name and password has to be created by the individual himself after getting activation mail from the administrator.

Procedure for University Staff:

For all the University officers, Faculty, Scientists and other staff, mail ID's and other details are taken from the SVVU dairy & SVVU website and activation mail has been sent to their respective mail ID's. After getting the activation mail, individual has to open the link provided in the activation mail and create his/her own password and save. Subsequently they can access the portal by using their User Name (E-mail address) & Password created by them.

Procedure for Students:

All U.G, P.G and PhD students are required to submit their e-mail ID and other details in the prescribed form available at their local College Library. After verification, the details will be sent to the administrator through e-mail by the College Librarian. The administrator will upload all details and send the activation mail to the respective student and student has to open the link provided in the activation mail and create his/her own password and save.

E-Resources available through SVVU E-resources portal

CeRA (Consortium for e-Resources in Agriculture) :

CeRA was established by ICAR in November, 2007 for facilitating accessibility of Scientific journals, E-Books, E-Databases to all Faculty/Scientists/Researchers / Students in the National Agricultural Research System (NARS) by providing access to information specially access to journals, books, statistics etc online which is crucial for having excellence in research and teaching. The following E-Resources are available through CeRA consortium.

E-Journals:

Total 3,964 e-journals from 15 publishers related to Agriculture, Veterinary, Fisheries and Dairy Science/Technology are available through CeRA.

E-Books :

CeRA has subscribed 1174 e-books along with 17 e-book series of Elsevier related to Agriculture, Veterinary, Fishery Science and Dairy Science/Technology and these E-Books are accessible through Sciencedirect.com

Indiaagristat.com :

CeRA is providing access to on-line statistical database Indiaagristat.com. It is a gateway to comprehensive and authentic socio-economic information related to Agriculture & Allied sectors of Indian Economy. All statistics related to Veterinary/Animal Husbandry, Fisheries, Dairy Science/Technology are available through this database.

Wiley Online Library :

CeRA is providing access to 85 Wiley Journals via Wiley Online library, out of these 31 journals are related to Veterinary & Animal Sciences.
