ZOOZOSES - GENERAL ASPECTS

- **Zoonosis** (noun): Zoonoses are diseases that involve a risk to human health from the diseases shared in nature by **plant and animals**.
- WHO in 1969 - defined that Zoonoses are "those diseases and infections which are naturally transmitted between vertebrate animals and man"
- **ZOOZOSES - AN INTERNATIONAL PROBLEM**- Zoonoses occur throughout the world transcending the natural boundaries through movements and transport of animal products.
- **ZOOZOSES-AN EMERGING PROBLEM**
 - Globalization change is the response of zoonotic diseases in many parts of the world.
 - Urbanization, industrialization and diminishing dependence of people working in the so-called primary sector.

According to the Mode of transmission

- **Direct zoonoses** - those zoonotic vertebrate host to a susceptible host mainly direct contact by contact or food-borne e.g. rabies, anthrax, brucellosis, leptospirosis, toxoplasmosis.
- **Cyclozoonoses** - require more than one vertebrate host species, but one vertebrate host for the completion of the life cycle of the agent, e.g. echinostomiasis, lamiasis.
- **Metazoonoses** - transmitted biologically by invertebrate vectors, in which the agent multiplies and/or develops & there is always an animal host, and before parasite is passed into transmission to another vertebrate host e.g. plague, infectious mononucleosis, schistosomiasis, leishmaniasis.
- **Saprozoonoses** - require a vertebrate host & non-animal developmental cycle like soil, plant material, pigman, decaying etc. for the development of the infectious agent e.g. streptococci, salmonellosis, cryptosporidiosis, toxoplasmosis, leishmaniasis.

ZOOZOSES - GENERAL ASPECTS

- **Zoonosis** (noun): Zoonoses are diseases that involve a risk to human health via the diseases shared in nature by **plant and animals**.
- WHO in 1969 - defined that Zoonoses are "those diseases and infections which are naturally transmitted between vertebrate animals and man"
- **ZOOZOSES - AN INTERNATIONAL PROBLEM**- Zoonoses occur throughout the world transcending the natural boundaries through movements and transport of animal products.
- **ZOOZOSES-AN EMERGING PROBLEM**
 - Globalization change is the response of zoonotic diseases in many parts of the world.
 - Urbanization, industrialization and diminishing dependence of people working in the so-called primary sector.

According to the Mode of transmission

- **Direct zoonoses** - those zoonotic vertebrate host to a susceptible host mainly direct contact by contact or via faeces e.g. rabies, anthrax, brucellosis, leptospirosis, toxoplasmosis.
- **Cyclozoonoses** - require more than one vertebrate host species, but one vertebrate host for the completion of the life cycle of the agent, e.g. echinostomiasis, lamiasis.
- **Metazoonoses** - transmitted biologically by invertebrate vectors, in which the agent multiplies and/or develops & there is always an animal host, and before parasite completed life in transmission to another vertebrate host e.g., plague, infectious mononucleosis, schistosomiasis, leishmaniasis.
- **Saprozoonoses** - require a vertebrate host & non-animal developmental cycle like soil, plant material, pigman, decaying etc. for the development of the infectious agent e.g., streptococci, salmonellosis, cryptosporidiosis, toxoplasmosis, listeriosis.

ETIOLOGY

- *Bacillus anthracis*
- Large, gram positive, non-motile, Aerobic and facultative anaerobe
- Two forms
 - Vegetative, spore
- Worldwide in distribution

Anthrax Spore





ENDO SPORES

- Very resistant
- Survive for decades
- Taken up by host and germinate
- Lethal dose 2,500 to 55,000 spores
- Biological warfare



TRANSMISSION IN HUMANS

- Cutaneous form is transmitted through cut on the skin
- Pulmonary form is transmitted through inhalation of spores (in and around terrorism)
- Intestinal form is due to ingestion of improperly cooked/uncooked beef or mutton





CLINICAL SIGNS

Cutaneous anthrax
 Total leukocytosis. Oozing of exudated blood from natural orifices, blood.

Pulmonary anthrax
 Fluorogent excreta, Dysentery

Intestinal anthrax
 Leukocytosis, colic and enteritis

cutaneous form : (Malignant pustule/ Ecthyma)


Pulmonary form : (Wool workers disease)
