☞ It is resolved to propagate Embryonic Stem Cells in the embryo genomics through incorporation of genes in pre-implantation embryos.

☞ It is resolved to advice the public to follow some beneficial behaviour modifications and better lifestyle choices for better reproductive health.

☞ It is resolved to extensively use advanced sperm phenotypic assessment tests for evaluation and assessment of bull fertility.
